

Burchette Wins Another for Rams

Havelock won its tenth straight game this season Friday by dropping the Beaufort Seadogs 8-1. The game was played at Beaufort.

Bill Burchette was the winning pitcher, as usual. He went the distance, striking out 13, walking only one and allowing two hits.

John Way got the loss. He was relieved in the fifth inning by Clem Woodard. Together, they struck out three, walked three and gave up six hits. The Seadogs committed seven errors to Havelock's one.

The Rams scored two runs in the first inning on two hits, a walk and three errors. The hits were by Phil Buzzelli and Brickly Scoggins. They picked up two more in the fourth, on a single by Clark Totherow, a triple by

Godwin and a sacrifice bunt by Tommy Dees.

Havelock scored four runs in the fifth inning on a single by Laufer, three Beaufort errors and a sacrifice fly by Scoggins. The Seadogs scored their only run in the seventh. Wayne Merrell reached first on a single, moved to second on an error by the Havelock shortstop and scored from second on a sacrifice bunt by Paul Biermann.
