

Devils Defeat Swansboro 5-1

Smyrna won its fifth straight game, the sixth win this season, at Swansboro Friday, 5-1.

Terry Lewis was the winning pitcher. He was relieved in the sixth by Kenny Lewis. Together, they struck out four, walked four and gave up five hits. The Devils committed only one error.

Cliff Waters was handed the loss. He went the distance, striking out nine, walking none and allowing six hits. The Pirates made two errors.

Smyrna's Doug Damren led off a four-run scoring streak in the second inning, with a single. Kenny Lewis doubled, moving Damren to third, and Tommy McGee

reached first on a fielder's choice to load the bases. A bunt single by Keith Piner scored Damren.

Charles Lawrence singled in Kenny Lewis, and McGee and Piner came on two Swansboro errors.

The Blue Devils pushed their lead to 5-0 with another run in the third. Joe (Boy) Willis made it to first on an error, but didn't stop until second. He scored on a single by Damren.

The Pirates scored in the fifth. Smith walked, and Waters, the losing pitcher, doubled him home. Swansboro threatened again in the seventh, with two men on, but couldn't score.

Smyrna is the county's only winning team to date. Their record is 6-4, with four games to be played.
