

# Morehead City Wins Third Straight For Championship

## James Webb Pitches 13th Win As Pennant Winners Triumph

Morehead City captured the 1949 Tidewater League championship Saturday at Smyrna when the local team whipped East Carteret, 8-6, to take its third straight game in a best three-of-five playoff series.

Biggs with three for four and two runs led the winners at the bat. He was followed by Green with two for four. Evans with two for three and two runs and Hawkins with two for four led the losers.

Winning pitcher was James Webb who chalked up his 13th victory for the season. Driver was the loser.

Throughout the season the Morehead City team led the league, chalking up a final season record of 27 won, four lost for an average of .871. The team's total for all games during the year, regular and playoffs, was 32 won, four lost for an average of .889.

East Carteret was in second place at the season's end with 23 won, 10 lost for a .697 average. Its final total for both playoffs and regular games was 27 won, 15 lost for a .643 average.
