

Newport Sweeps Pair From Dixon Tuesday

Newport's Hawks continued on their merry way Tuesday night as they swept a twin bill from Dixon at the home court, winning the feature contest 78-50 and the preliminary 60-58.

The victory in the boys game marked the 15th win in 16 starts for the Hawks and their 12th straight.

The Hawks moved out to a 15-8 lead at the end of the first quarter and extended their advantage to 38-23 at halftime. At the end of three quarters they were well ahead 68-38.

Leston Gillikin paced the scoring parade for the victors with 23 points as teammates Al Wallace 17 and Gil Garner 11, also scored in double figures.

Parker was high for the losers with 15 markers as Davis tallied 11.

The preliminary contest saw

Newport maintain a narrow one-point lead at the end of the initial canto 14-13, and then a two-point margin at halftime 30-28. Newport moved a little further ahead in the third quarter and led at the end of the stanza 51-43.
