

Atlantic Routs Newport Twice Sunday, Moves Into Top Spot in County Loop

Atlantic's All-Stars moved into first place in the County Baseball League by virtue of their twin victories over Newport on Sunday.

Salter Path, who had held the lead, fell to fourth as they dropped a pair to Smyrna-Harkers Island 5-2 and 11-5, and Beaufort swept their doubleheader from the Coast Guard 7-5, and 6-5.

Atlantic routed Newport in both ends of their twin-bill, winning the opener 13-2 and the nightcap 17-1.

Salter Wins Sixth

Tommy Salter won his sixth straight for Atlantic in the opener and Johnny Willis won the second tilt. Losing hurlers for Newport were Lloyd Culpepper and Jarvis Guthrie.

At Smyrna-Harkers Island Jamie Lewis and Osborne Davis posted the double victory with the losses going to Jerry Pittman and Mel Adcox. Osborne won in relief of Wilson Davis.

Jamie Lewis, winning hurler in the first game, had two round-trippers in the nightcap, getting one with the bases loaded and the other with one man aboard. In all he batted in eight runs in the second game.

Beaufort Wins Pair

At Morehead City the Beaufort team, winners of seven of their last eight games, posted two close decisions over the Coast Guard, winning the first game 7-5 behind Jimmy Parkins and the second tilt, 6-5 behind Monk Pittman. Losing hurlers were Charlie Braxton and Earl Taylor.

Parkins had the lone homer of the day in the second contest.

Willis Hits

Johnny Willis was the leading hitter of the day with 5-11 for Atlantic. Other hitters were John Hamilton, Atlantic, 2-4; Lloyd Culpepper and Harold McCabe, Newport, 2-5; Henry Frost, Salter Path, 4-6; Bruce Babbitt, Smyrna-HI, 3-5; Jamie Lewis, Smyrna-HI, 3-6.

Jimmy Fodrie, 3-4; Jimmy Parkins, 3-5; Icky Peterson and Pierson Willis, 1-1; Monk Pittman, 2-3; James Holland, 2-4, and Billy Eudy, 2-5, all of Beaufort; Henry O'Briant, 2-4, Arthur, 1-2, and Red Harker, Charlie Braxton, Lewis and Modlin, 1-3, all of the Coast Guard.

Atlantic is now in first place, Smyrna-Harkers Island in second, Beaufort in third, Salter Path in fourth, Newport in fifth and the Coast Guard in the cellar.
