Beaufort Boys WON 35-24 Girls WON

It was the up-settingest upset of the season Friday night when Beaufort kayoed Morehead City 35-24 at Beaufort. Beaufort girls made their expected win with 39-23.

Coach Gannon Talbert's comment Saturday morning was: "We were just outplayed. The refereeing was all right, the people were all right, we were just outplayed."

Morehead Leads

Morehead City led by two points at the end of the first quarter, but Beaufort put on steam in the second, and the half finished with Beaufort leading by one point, 18-17.

The underdogs, then realizing that they weren't playing the supermen they expected, scored 10 points in the third quarter to the favored Eagles' five, and in the last quarter, Beaufort held Morehead to only two points while tallying seven. At the final whistle the score stood at 35-24.

Owens High Scorer

Clyde Owens took high score honors for Beaufort with 9. John Lynch scored 8. Billy Eudy and B. G. O'Neal 5 each. Louis Woodard and James Parkin 4 each. Of Beaufort's 15 free throws, 11 whipped the cords.

Strug Steed of Morehead was the highest individual scorer in the game with 12 points. Mickey Woolard tallied 6, Bob Matthews 4, and Tom Bennett 2. Morehead made 16 of their 24 free throws count.
