

Salter Path Dumps Coast Guard to Retain Top Spot

Salter Path moved a full game ahead of Atlantic Sunday in the County Baseball League as they dumped the hapless Coast Guard, 13-3 and 10-0, while Atlantic was winning one from Beaufort, 9-4.

The second game of the scheduled doubleheader was tied at 10-10 after 7 innings when it was called due to the 6 o'clock curfew.

Salter Path had a field day at bat. They collected 32 hits in the two games. Jarvis Guthrie pitched a four-hit shut out in the second game, after Mel Adcox had yielded three runs on six hits in the opener.

32 Hits

Salter Path combined 32 hits, including a double by Lloyd Frost and a homer by Jarvis Guthrie, and two sterling pitching performances to take their twin victories.

Big guns in the Salter Path attack were Lloyd Frost with six for eight, George Lewis with five for nine, and Jim Parker with five for ten.

In the opener of the Atlantic Beaufort doubleheader, Tom Salter held Beaufort to four runs as his mates piled up a comfortable five-run working margin. Jim Parkins, the losing pitcher, had better luck at bat than in his specialty, as he collected four hits in six tries.

Game Halted

With the score tied at 10 apiece, the curfew called a halt. The game will be made up after the regular season ends next Sunday.

The League has announced that after the make-up games a play-off series will be run. The first place and fourth place teams and the second and third place teams will play in the opening round with the two winners meeting for the championship.
