

Atlantic Meets Salter Path For Play-Off Title Sunday

Atlantic scored a 10-3 victory over Smyrna-HI Sunday afternoon to gain a shot at Salter Path in the play-off finals next Sunday.

The game will be played at Salter Path at 1:30.

The first inning saw Atlantic score six runs to wrap up the win, and Smyrna-HI score three before Thomas Salter could get out a man.

Wilson Davis started for Smyrna-HI and struck out the first man to face him. His luck ran out then, and a couple of hits and several errors later he got the third out—after six runs had scored.

Salter had his lumps in the first inning, too. The first two men to face him hit safely, and Mack Pigott came to the plate and poled a home run about 450 feet into the woods.

Salter pitched air-tight ball from that point on, however, scattering six hits through the remainder of the seven inning contest.

Atlantic scored four more in the second inning with Roy Willis coming in to relieve Davis. Willis was replaced by Osborne Davis in the fourth and he pitched shut-out ball for the last three innings.

Mack Pigott was the batting star for the losers as he drove in all three runs with his first inning homer. Buddy Willis got five for five to lead the Atlantic attack.
