

Salter Path Lays Claim to Baseball League Title

Salter Path laid claim to the county league play-off championship Sunday after Atlantic forfeited a doubleheader. Atlantic forfeited the first play-off game Sept. 9 after eight innings, in protest of an umpire's decision.

Atlantic manager **John** Hamilton notified Salter Path Sunday that he didn't have enough players to field a full team. The forfeiture gives Salter Path three wins in a best two of three series for the title.
