"The Johnson boys will probably be the top two starters," said Pfohl, "with Harper the No. 3 man. Stovall and Glover (2-0 last year) will be probable pitchers. I'll have to wait and

see how Hedgepeth comes along."

Three infield positions appear set with letterman Ronnie Pace at first, Vic Camechis, a transfer from Chowan, at second and Chuck Fleet, another ex-Chowan player, at third. The shortstop spot is up for grabs between Jerry Waddell and letterman Tommy Carter.

Outfield

In the outfield, Walt Moore, a speedy Louisburg transfer, looks set in center, while ex-Wingate Junior College star Rick Arrington is the No. 1 right fielder. Hedgepeth or Ed Corraway (of basketball fame) will play in left.

Willis is the No. 1 catcher and he's backed up by letterman Gary Farmer, a Wilson boy.

"Willis led Chowan in fitting, home runs, etc. and the team's MVP," beamed Pfohl. "He

even led the team in stolen bases. And he's a fine catcher. Farmer is a good one, too,

so we're not hurting for catchers."

The AC baseball diamond is obviously a sunny place to be.
