

Seadogs Down Pamlico 4-1 At Beaufort

Beaufort Seadogs won out over Pamlico Tuesday, 4-1, in a hard-fought pitching and batting battle. Three runs in the sixth for Beaufort put the clincher to the game, played on the Seadogs' home field.

The action in the sixth began with a double by Ray Hassell followed by a triple by Chuck Lewis. Leslie Croom got on base with an error, one of the two by Pamlico. Two singles by Wayne Merrill and Alton Hill brought in the rest of the men on base for three runs.

The Seadogs' pitcher, Parris Croom, ended the game with no earned runs, 14 strike-outs and only three hits allowed. Croom got a double in the fourth, and Leslie Croom also got a double in the same inning. Pitching for Pamlico was Potter.

Beaufort had one error in the play. Alton Hill got two for three and Parris Croom's double gave him one for two.
