Blue Devils, BFD Win Pony League Games

The Smyrna Blue Devils won the opening game of Friday night's Pony League doubleheader as they edged the Morehead City Black Hawks 5-3 and extended their unbeaten string to six games.

The Blue Devils scored all five of their runs in the first inning and then stood off three Black Hawk rallies.

After getting leadoff hitter Cranston Jones to ground out, Morehead's starting pitcher, Rodney Kemp ran into control trouble and walked four of the next five batters. An error, a passed ball, and a single by Steve Willis cleared the base paths and gave the Blue Devils their lead.

The Black Hawks fought back to score single runs in each the second, third and fourth frames but couldn't quite catch the Blue Devils.

Donnie Gillikin started for the Blue Devils but was lifted in favor of righthander Kenny Lewis in the second inning. Lewis finished up allowing the Black Hawks three hits.

Friday's nitecap saw another close contest as the BFD nine came from behind in the sixth inning to tally twice on a homerun by second sacker Johnnie Merrill

which provided the BFD a 4-3 edge over the Newport Comets.

Merrill lined his shot on a 3-2 pitch with team mate Clem Woodard aboard. Woodard had walked and taken second on a passed ball.

Woodard went the route on the mound for the winners while the loss was charged to Newport's Minatel.

Merrill's blast was the only scoring in the game since the first inning when the Comets shoved across three runs and the BFD two.

The win moved the BFD into second place in the league standings two games behind Smyrna and two games ahead of the Comets who are now tied with the Black Hawks for third place.
