

Seadogs Shut Out Swansboro With Parris Croom on Mound

→ Beaufort Seadogs had a two-inning field day Tuesday night, scoring 16 runs on Swansboro in a game that ended 16-0. The game, played under the lights at Beaufort, saw Seadog pitcher Parris Croom pitch a no-hit, no-run game.

Beaufort got eight runs from four hits in the first inning and eight runs from six hits in the second from Coy, pitching for Swansboro. Pate relieved Coy for the remainder of the game, holding the Seadogs in check.

Doing the honors at bat for the Seadogs were Richard Stanley with two for three and a triple in the first, Parris Croom with two for four and a double, and Chuck Lewis and Leslie Croom with a double each.
