

## Smyrna-HI Drops Twin Cities Into County League Celler

Smyrna-Harkers Island climbed out of the cellar of the county baseball league Sunday afternoon at Smyrna. They took 7-6 and 14-1 victories over the current celler-dwellers, Twin Cities. The victories left Smyrna-HI with a 2-4 record. Twin Cities has lost all four of its games.

Mack Pigott was the winning pitcher for both Smyrna victories. He went in the first game in the seventh inning to replace Laurie Willis with the score standing 5-4 in favor of Twin Cities. The visitors scored once more in the seventh inning to go ahead by two big runs.

### Rally Staged

Smyrna-HI rallied in the bottom of the seventh to tie the score at six all and left the winning run stranded on third base. Pigott held the Twin City batters in the top of the eighth. In the bottom of the extra inning, Smyrna-HI pushed across one run to take the victory.

The second game was a run-away as Smyrna-HI scored 14 runs in the first four innings. Twin Cities took its turn at bat in the fifth and scored its lone run. The

officials called the game due to darkness at the end of the top of the fifth.

Pigott went the distance for the winners, allowing only two hits in the five innings. Smyrna batters collected 13.

### 12 Score

In the fourth inning, Smyrna-HI sent 17 men to the plate with 12 of them scoring.

Jamie Lewis had a field day at bat, collecting six hits in his eight trips to the plate. He scored three runs.

Mack Pigott was a leading batter for the day—as well as being the winning pitcher in both games. In the first game he got one for three, and in the second game he hit two for three, including a triple.

Holland was the big stick for the losers with four for seven, including a double in the first game.
