

Salter Path Takes Two Games At Cherry Point

Mel Adeox posted his fourth victory Sunday afternoon as he hurled Salter Path to an 11-1 victory over MTRG-20 in the first game of a doubleheader at Cherry Point. Salter Path took the second game 11-3. This made him the winningest pitcher in the league with a 4-0 record. Another leftie, Thomas Salter, has a 3-0 record for Atlantic.

Adeox allowed but five hits as he went the full seven innings for the winners. He struck out seven batters.

The visitors jumped on Marine pitcher Eiduke for one run in the first inning. In the second inning they really teed off on his offerings, batting around and scoring six runs. The winners scored two in the third and two more in the fifth.

Adeox had a shut-out until the last inning, when Goodrow scored the lone Marine tally.

Bradley McIntosh went the distance for the winners in the second game, giving up three runs on six

hits. He had a seven-run cushion to work on before he ever took the mound.

Salter Path scored seven times in the top of the first inning and led 9-0 before the Marines could scratch. The home team drove two runs across in the bottom of the third inning and got their last tally in the last of the seventh.

Gene Haskett was the leading batter for the winners with five hits in eight trips to the plate. George Lewis had four for six and Harold Bass collected two hits in three trips to the plate.

Leading batters for the Marines were Aultman with three for six and Brown with three for eight.
