

Salter Path Takes Pair From Smyrna-III Sunday

Salter Path hung onto second place in the county baseball loop with a pair of victories over Smyrna-III Sunday afternoon at Salter Path. Mel Adecox picked up his sixth victory of the season in the first game, striking out 10 and allowing 10 hits for a 8-2 victory.

Jarvis Guthrie hurled the second game, allowing six runs on 11 hits. His teammates staked him to a 15-run lead in the first five innings, so the final score was 15-6.
