Among his stalwarts on the mound will be Jerry Pittman, Earle Wade, Ronald Howland, and Bobby McIntosh.

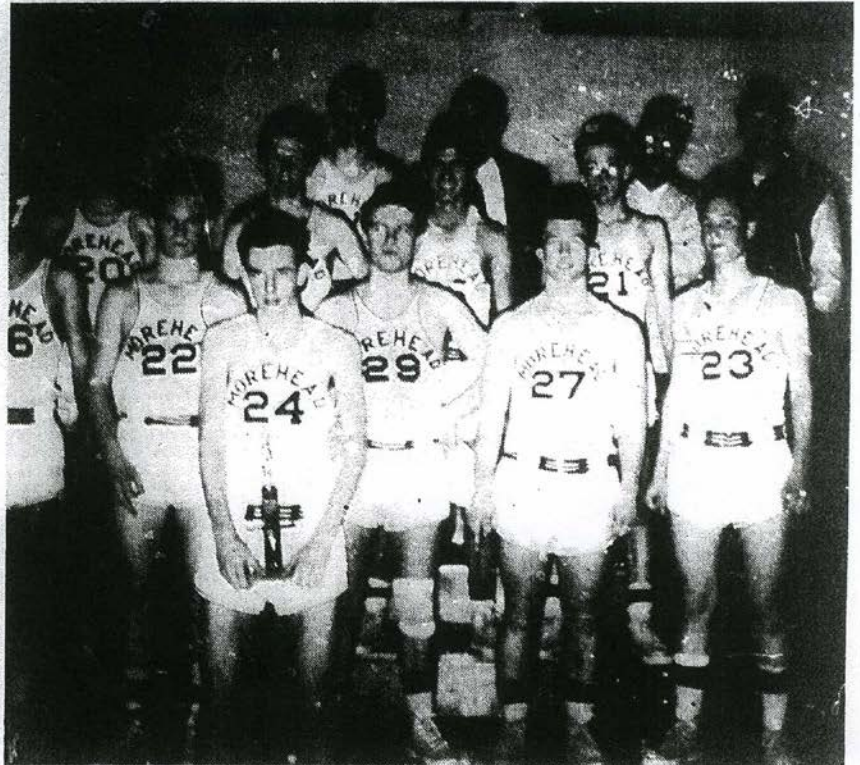
Best looking prospect at this time is catcher John Glancy.
