

Pamlico Continues Unbeaten Skein Walloping Smyrna, 14-0, Thursday

Pamlico County's undefeated baseball team made it seven straight victories Thursday afternoon at Smyrna as they rode roughshod over Smyrna's previously unbeaten nine, 14-0.

Joe Gahagan, Pamlico's ace left-hander, twirled one-hit ball over the seven inning contest, and faced but 21 men in the process.

The lone basehit was garnered by Crawford Piggott in the fourth inning and he was cut down trying to steal second.

Mack O'Neal was the starting and losing pitcher for Smyrna with Roy Styron coming in as relief in the fifth frame.

Pamlico opened the scoring in the top of the first when they put together two hits, two walks and two Smyrna errors for three runs.

In the top of the second they tallied three more as they combined a hit, a walk, one hit batsman and another Smyrna miscue.

In the fourth the Spuds of Pamlico scored four times and the score jumped to 10-0, as they had two hits, three walks and another Smyrna error.

The final scoring was done at the expense of Styron in the top of the

final frame as the Spuds put together two hits, a walk, a hit batsman, and yet another Smyrna miscue for four tallies, to make the final score Pamlico 14, Smyrna 0.

Leading the hitting attack for Pamlico were Ken Dixon and Lloyd Carawan, each of whom had 2-4.

Smyrna committed six miscues in the game and they played a big part in making the game a complete rout.
