

Seadogs Score 4 in 3rd To Down Havelock 4-3

The Beaufort Seadogs scored four runs in the third inning Friday afternoon then held on to score a 4-3 win over the Havelock Rams in a baseball game played on the Beaufort diamond. The win was the fifth in a row for the undefeated Seadogs.

Lefthander Pud Hassell started on the mound for the Seadogs and limited the Rams to three hits. He

struck out nine and walked four in registering his third win of the season. Zimmer, who went the route for the Rams, was tagged with the loss.

The next batter, Pud Hassell, reached first on a fielder's choice and then Chuck Lewis stepped to the plate and lined a three-run single. Zimmer retired the side by getting Parris and Leslie Croom to ground out.

Havelock scored its runs on single tallies in the second, fifth and sixth innings.
