

# ATLANTIC DOUBLES SCORE OF PIRATES

ATLANTIC, Aug. 8—By a score of 4 to 2 the Locals evened their standing of the season with the Wilmington Pirates here today. But the game was marred by the serious accident to the Pirates' fast shortstop, H. In the sixth the victors tied the score with their final run, using a pair of hits and Atlantic's favor of two errors. The locals tallied once in the next period by hitting three times, and in the eighth they made their last run on Wilmington's only two errors of the game and Hill's third hit.
