## Smyrna Took First Place In Twelve Events; Good Present

SMYRNA, April 5 — Smyrna won the Curteret County Rural High School Track meet overwhelmingly scoring 76 1/2 points to Newport's 34 1-2 and Atlantic's 6. Smyrna (won first place in twelve of the thirteen events, losing only to Newport in the girls 50 yard dash. This aroused the Smyrna girls so that they later won the girls' relay by a half lap. But the boys' relay which was the last event furnished the most thrilling finish of the day. Pigott running last for Smyrna began with fully a five yard handicap. The Newport entrant was running prettily and seemed to have the race at the halfway mark. But no! This Pigott boy, who had already won four events for his team, again felt the urge. He sprinted - he passed him. He holds that scant yard – He wins and the Carteret County track meet is history.

The meet was held at Smyrna. There was a good crowd of interested spectators and rooters. Everything went off as smoothly as one could1 wish. The crowd was noted for its order and jollity. There existed the finest spirit and good sportsmanship between the competitors.
