

#63E 2005 East Carteret High School Football – Won the Mullet Bucket 42-7! (Record 12-3); Coach Keifer






When asked how Coach Keifer helped him, quarterback T.J. Courman replied, "Aside from football he has tought me what it really means to become a man of destination."
