Varsity Football Ends the Season With a Record-Setting Victory

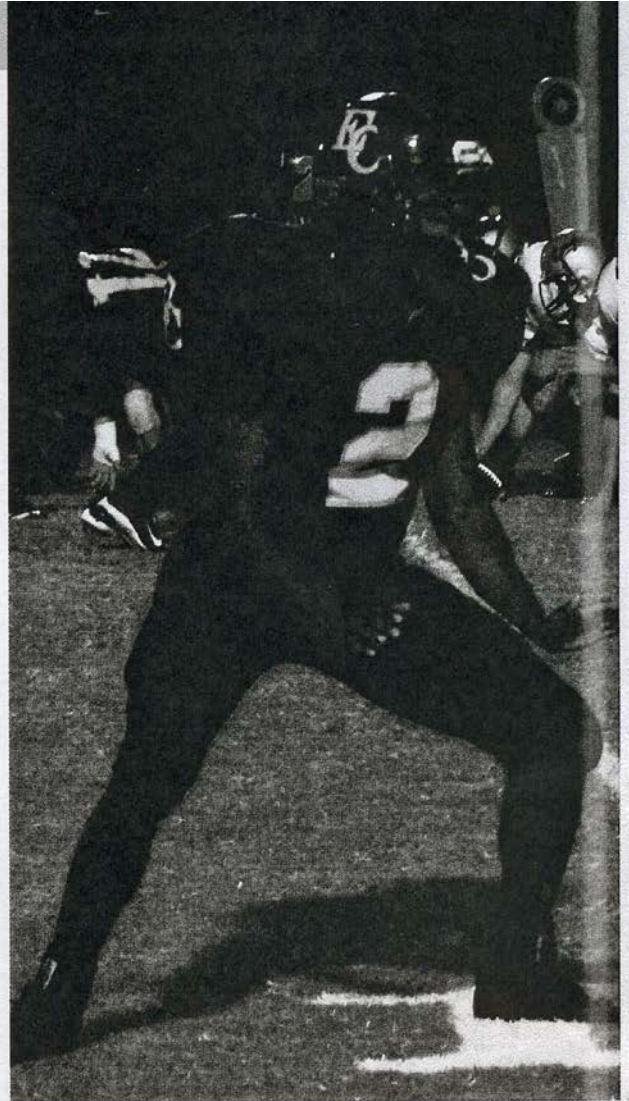
