

- April 16, 1957 he stole home for the winning run that allowed Atlantic HS to beat out Smyrna 6 to 5 for the County Baseball Championship
- Member of the 1957 Atlantic Carteret County League Championship Team that had a record of 24-2
- Serviced in the U.S. Coast Guard and graduated from East Carolina University in 1961 and began his teaching career at Atlantic
- He also taught at Pitt County, nine years in Roberson County and served as President of the N.C. Teacher's Association before returning to Atlantic as Principal for 14 years
